Its two main international airports receive hundreds of monthly flights from major cities, facilitating the constant mobilization of passengers through safe and modern facilities. The Juan Santamaría International Airport (SJO) is the country's main airport, located in Alajuela. The modern Daniel Oduber International Airport in Liberia (LIR) receives specific flights primarily for tourists visiting the regions of Guanacaste, Monteverde and La Fortuna. In the Pacific region, temperatures range from 28°C to 38°C (82°F to 100°F), while along the Caribbean coast the highest temperature is 30°C. Temperatures in the country's central region range from 22°C to 28°C (71°F to 75°F), while in the mountainous regions it can drop to 7°C (44°F).
